What is No Place Like Home?

Membership in No Place Like Home (NPLH) is for people who are actively homeschooling children in Three Rivers, MI and the surrounding communities. NPLH is a Christian not-for-profit community support group, not a private school. We offer supplemental social and academic activities but do not provide core instruction, grant credits or issue diplomas.

Who belongs to NPLH? NPLH families are an eclectic bunch. We do not all attend the same church. We do not all use the same curriculum. We do not all have kids the same age. What we DO have in common is a desire to encourage one another. We emphasize respectful social interactions, creative fun and an enthusiastic audience for academic reports, displays and investigations.

How does NPLH operate? We are a cooperative group. We keep participation fees low and **expect all members to volunteer to some extent with the year's programming.** The NPLH Board is comprised of a President, VP/Membership Chair, Secretary, Treasurer and Activities Chair. These are veteran NPLH members who volunteer to take care of administrative tasks so the rest of the Membership can coordinate exciting individual events throughout the year. All coordinators work in teams and all participants chip in to help out. We make connections this way, and that's what the group's about!
